The Parish Board of Education is now accepting nominations and applications to fill four openings on the board for a three-year term. Three openings are filled by election, one is appointed by Msgr. Shamleffer.

The role of the Board of Education is to provide support and guidance to the Pastor and to the School Administration on school issues. Key components of board activities are in policy, marketing, financial planning and budgeting, and technology planning. The board also supports educational opportunities identified by administration and faculty and school/church building and safety needs. The board serves in an advisory capacity. It is a wonderful opportunity to support the parish school, its administration, faculty, and students.

The board meets on the third Thursday of the month, ten months of the year. Committees within the board may meet between board meetings to work on projects.

Candidates should be registered members of the parish, OR may be school parents who are not registered in the parish but who have a child or children in school.
